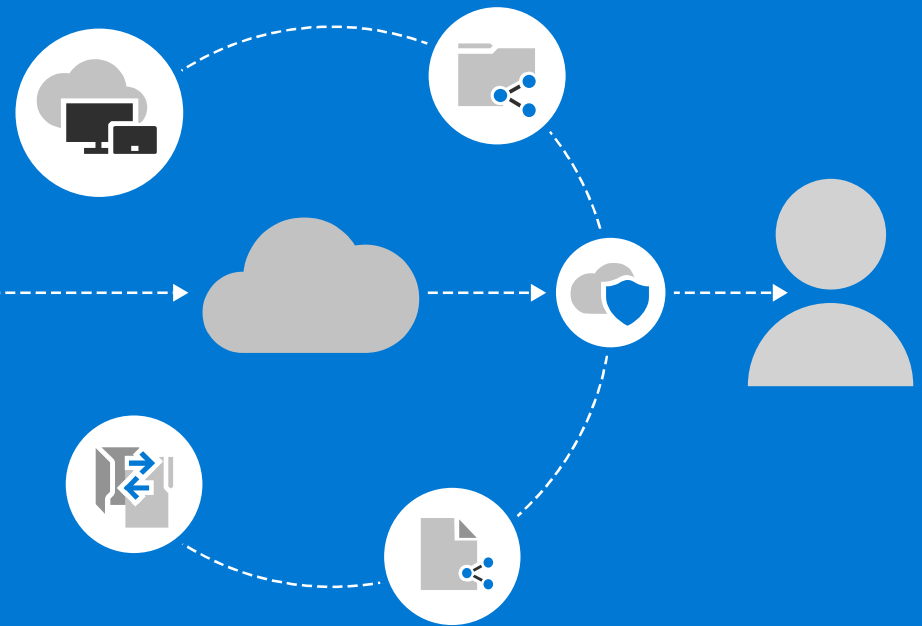


Nurses' Guide to Basic Aspects of Telehealth
